*** The BSN program requires an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN or AAS) or Diploma in Nursing, and will utilize **33 technical hours** toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Transfer Credit Limit

UHCL will accept **90 hours** for the transfer courses toward the BSN degree requirements. Students **MUST** complete their AAS prior to transferring, and is recommended to also transfer [Texas Core](#) Complete. However you may transfer and continue to complete your remaining Texas Core requirements through your current college or through UH-Clear Lake main campus while also completing the remainder of the BSN upper-level coursework through UHCL's Pearland location.

This Bachelor's degree is 120 hours. The remaining course requirements (**30 hours**) are to be completed through UHCL. The major requirements for Nursing must be completed through UHCL's [Pearland Campus](#) and/or Online.
