This report consists of a 4 year demographic study for Spring terms. The demographic data pages present actual UHCL certified data extracted from a PeopleSoft query for inclusion of each student's most current Academic Plan record. Student level data uses a CBM-001 extract and SCH information is derived from the CBM-001 student report as well. If variance exists when comparing these figures to other previously published reports, it is important to note that these data may follow a different methodology. Totals by school and classification have all been verified with actual certified THECB

N = Actual number of cases; % = Column percent; n/a = not applicable



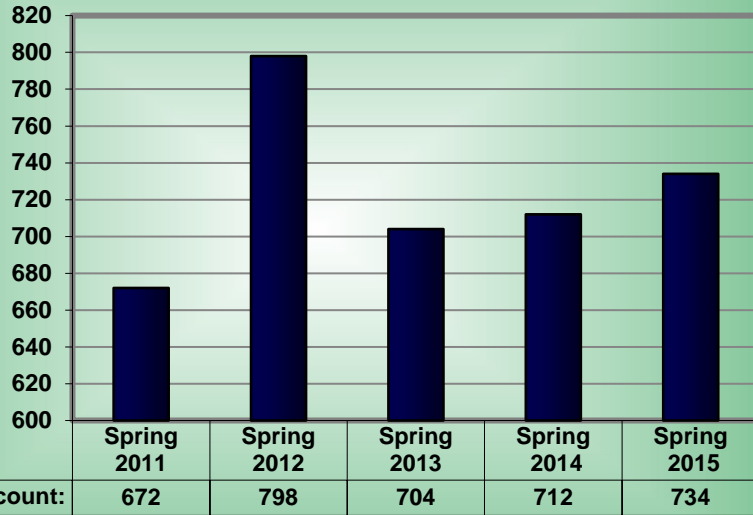

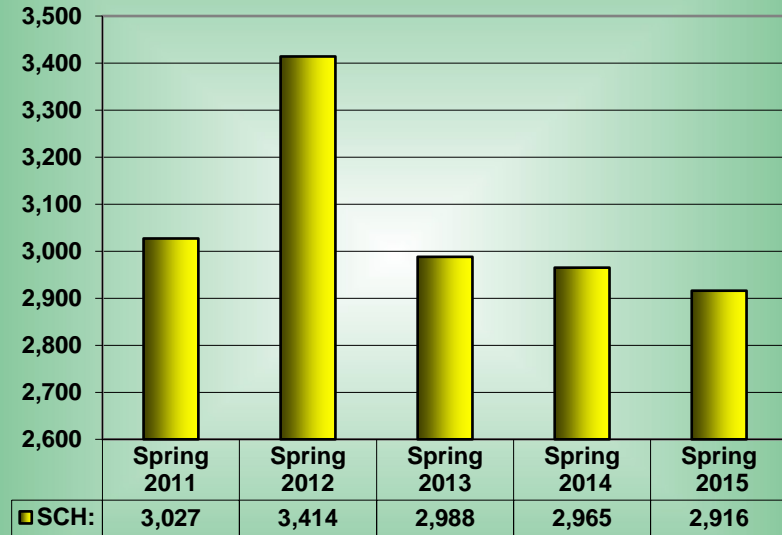

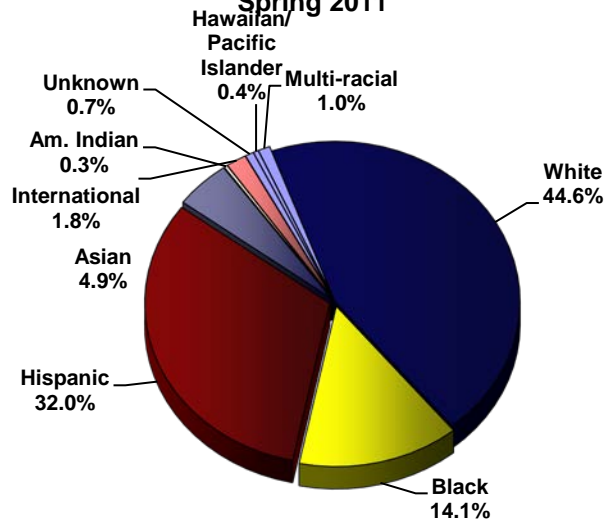
Total UHCL Pearland: Headcount Trends



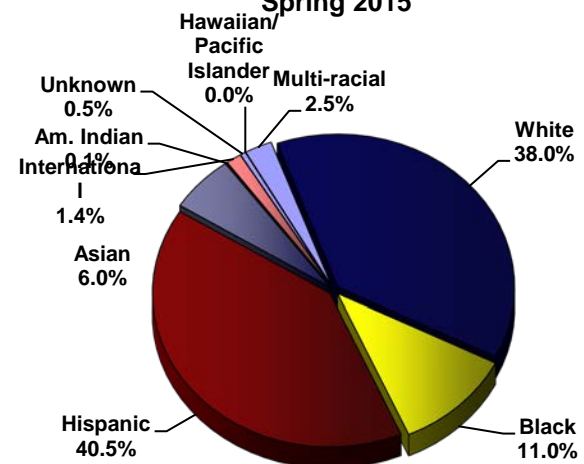
Total UHCL Pearland: Semester Credit Hour Trends
