Outcome #1

Outcome #3

Students will demonstrate creativity through the production of an original work within the discipline.

Criteria for Success:

80% of students will achieve at least a satisfactory rating.

Status (Spring 2016):

86.0% of students earned at least a satisfactory rating - either excellent or acceptable.

Outcome #4

Students will communicate outcomes through writing and/or presentations.

Criteria for Success:

80% of students will achieve at least a satisfactory rating.

Status (Spring 2016):

90.7% of students earned at least a satisfactory rating - either excellent or acceptable.
