Outcome #1

80% of students will achieve at least a satisfactory rating.

**80.7%** of students earned at least a satisfactory rating - either excellent or acceptable.

Outcome #2

Students will make connections to their particular issues or problems based upon evidence acquired by research methodologies and citation methods within the discipline.

80% of students will achieve at least a satisfactory rating.

**85.5%** of students earned at least a satisfactory rating - either excellent or acceptable.

Outcome #3
