Academic Council Bylaws

1.1 Charge

Academic Council (AC) will make recommendations on all policies as outlined in UHCL MAP 01.A.01. The AC will make final recommendations to the Provost on all academic matters including but not limited to:

- Enrollment and admission
- Scholarships
- Catalog revisions
- Curriculum issues
- Degree requirements
- SACS accreditation

2.1 Membership

The Academic Council (AC) shall have representatives from the academic administration, the Council of Professors and Faculty Senate, and be chaired by the Provost. The AC voting membership is as follows:

- Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost*
- Vice Provost
- Associate Provost for Research and Sponsored Programs
- Sr. Associate Vice President for Information Technology
- Associate Vice President for Student Success
- Academic Deans (4)
- Faculty Senate (8)
- Representative from the Council of Professors (1)
- Representative from the Council of Chairs (1)

*The Provost is the only officer and chair of Academic Council. Since the charge of AC is to make recommendations to the Provost, the Provost will not serve as a voting member.

3.1 Amendments

Amendments to the Bylaws require two-thirds (12) of voting membership approval.
