ACTION ITEMS

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the November 10, 2022, meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Academic Council

Provost Maynard presented eight items that were approved by Academic Council from the Faculty Senate committee on November 17, 2022. A revised policy on certificates was passed this year to ensure all certificates throughout the University completely go through the shared governance process and are approved. Dr. Lastrapes explained that there were two minors from Literacy, five certificates, and CLEP AP. CLEP and AP credits will not be capped at 30 hours. Anyone coming in with more than 30 hours would be accepted in alignment with what they do in the system.

Academic Council

Chair, Dr. Christopher Maynard

No agenda items.

Dr. Huss-Keeler presented on the internal Wayfinding committee being reconstituted with representatives across UHCL. FSSC will review sections of the existing UHCL Master Plan from 2017 starting in January.

Several items were discussed with the Parking Committee, but no actions were taken. These items will be considered by Mr. Kitchen and voted on during the next Parking meeting in January.

Dr. Walker announced that the Civic Engagement group committee would continue to work with Harris County. This will allow UHCL to continue to serve as a polling location for early and regular voting. UHCL was the only site to exceed early voting expectations.

University Life Committee (ULC) Chair, Dr. Angela Kelling

Dr. Kelling reported that the student center fee budget for fiscal years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 was approved. ULC bylaws were updated.

Mr. Denney presented that the Texas Education Code requires ULC to review the budget for the Student Center fee. We currently charge \$30 a semester, and the education code allows the student center fee to go up to \$40. The proposal for 2022-2023 is to use the fund balance to pay for the referendum costs. There is a proposal for modest upgrades within the 1st floor of the Student Center. They do not have cost estimates for some renovations to support the Hawk Pantry, Clothing Closet, and the relocation of the Orientation and New Student Programs office. Currently, the fund balance is over \$700,000 a year.
