- PSYC 1100 - Learning Framework
 - **Required** during first semester
 - **Co-requisite** with **specific** sections of US History I, US History II, Federal Government, or Texas Government
 - Stand alone PSYC 1100 option for those who completed History **and** Government

Example:

- HIST 1301 - 01 MoWeFr 10:00AM – 10:50AM
 - PSYC 1100 – 01, Tu 8:00AM - 9:50AM
 - PSYC 1100 – 02, We 1:00PM - 2:50PM
- Already registered based on pre-advising
