### Transfer Guide Notes

\* Any extra Texas Core classes completed may end up satisfying these—check with a [UHCL Transfer Advisor](#) prior to enrolling in any Component Area Option 090 courses.

\*\*This program requires a minimum of 15 hours of Child Development (CDEC) courses or an Associates of Applied Science (AAS) in a Child Development field to be completed prior to transferring to UHCL for the Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) degree. Students who have NOT completed 15 hours of CDEC at their community college should apply for the [BS in Early Childhood Care and Education](#) program.

### Transfer Credit Limit

UHCL will accept up to **69 hours** for the transfer courses listed above toward the BS degree requirements, however students may [apply to transfer](#) at any time **after completing the 15 hours of CDEC course requirements**.
