## II. FIELD OF STUDY (18 hours)

The additional Field of Study (FOS) courses CRIJ 1306, CRIJ 1310, CRIJ 2313, and CRIJ 2328; and up to 6 hours of Directed Electives will be utilized toward the 120 hour requirements for the B.S. in Criminology and Criminal Justice degree.

## **Transfer Credit Limit**

UHCL will accept all **60 hours** of the courses listed above in transfer <u>toward this particular degree's requirements</u>. Recommend to follow the Associate of Arts in Social and Behavioral Sciences or General Studies at the community college in order to incorporate the <u>Field of Study (FOS)</u> and other Social Sciences classes toward the A.A. "Transfer Path" requirements. However you may transfer and continue to complete your remaining <u>Texas Core</u> requirements through your current college or through UH-Clear Lake main campus while also completing the upper-level coursework.

This Bachelor's degree is 120 hours. The remaining course requirements (60 hours) are to be completed through the UH-Clear Lake main campus or through the UH-Cl Online completer program option.
