

College of Business Graduate Admission Requirements by Program

Applications for admission to a graduate program in the College of Business will be considered under one of two sets of criteria. One does not require submission of a standardized test score. If an applicant doesn't meet the criteria for a test score waiver, the application will be considered with the submission of a standardized test score.
