Selection Criteria

A nominee will be evaluated by the following criteria which demonstrates the traits, characteristics and actions that alumni reflect upon as important to them during their time as students at UHCL:

1. Active involvement with students outside the classroom, such as through student organizations, shared governance and mentoring.
2. Generous commitment of time and spirit to students and the university.
3. Creative, innovative teaching that instructs and inspires students, and who embody the fulfillment of learning and discovery.
4. Sincere involvement in building a sense of community among students.
5. Deeply passionate about the university, its mission and the potential for change through education.

Nomination Requirements

Only graduates and/or recipients of teacher's certificates from UHCL may nominate. Please consider the following requirements when preparing the nomination package:

Each nominee must:

1. Be currently employed as a professor* at UHCL at the time of the nomination deadline.
2. Have been a professor at UHCL for at least five years.
3. Accept the award in person at the UHCL Alumni Celebration dinner.
4. Not be a previous recipient of this award.
5. Not be a current member of the Alumni Association Executive Council.

**Professors, according to the UHCL Provost's Office, are "full-time faculty members who perform the functions of teaching a minimum of three courses per semester, conduct peer reviewed research in his/her discipline, and provide service to the university and community."*

SECTION 3 – AUTOMATIC INELIGIBILITY

An individual shall be ruled ineligible to receive the Outstanding Professor Award if any of the following conditions prevail at the time the selection committee meets to consider nominations:

1. Nominee is a candidate for any public office.
2. Nominee is a member of the selection committee.
3. Nominee is a previous recipient of the award.
4. Nominee has been convicted of a felony.

Professional Affiliations – Required

Student Related Activities and Service – Required

Include year, organization and type of service provided.

Honors and Awards – Required

Include sponsor and date of award.
