CLEP Exams



Timed, **computer-based** exams



Students receive **immediate** score results (with exception of essays)



Exams can be offered **whenever** a student is ready;
90 day retest



CLEP is scored on a scale from **20 – 80**. ACE recommends college credit at 50



Over **2900** colleges and universities award credit for CLEP



Cost of a CLEP exam is **\$93**

Identifying CLEP test takers

Financial savings

The cost of CLEP is \$93 and on average earns a student with a passing score 3 college credits which promotes big cost savings for families making college more affordable.

Transfer students

CLEP is used by students who are looking at transferability of credits.

Adults returning to college

CLEP can be used to meet graduation requirements and free up time in a semester for extra curricular or improved work/life balance.

Scholarship opportunity

Schools can order CLEP vouchers and cover the cost of CLEP exams for their students.

On time graduation

CLEP can be an excellent tool in keeping students on track to graduate on time or early!



CLEP in Practice: High School

Identifying CLEP test takers

2nd chance at college credit

High school students who may have missed a college credit granting score in AP use CLEP as an additional opportunity

Students seeking to save money

The cost of CLEP is \$90 and on average earns a student with a passing score 3 college credits which promotes big cost savings for families making college more affordable.

CLEP in non-AP subjects

Many high schools use CLEP as an early college credit opportunity in non-AP subjects like College Algebra or Sociology.

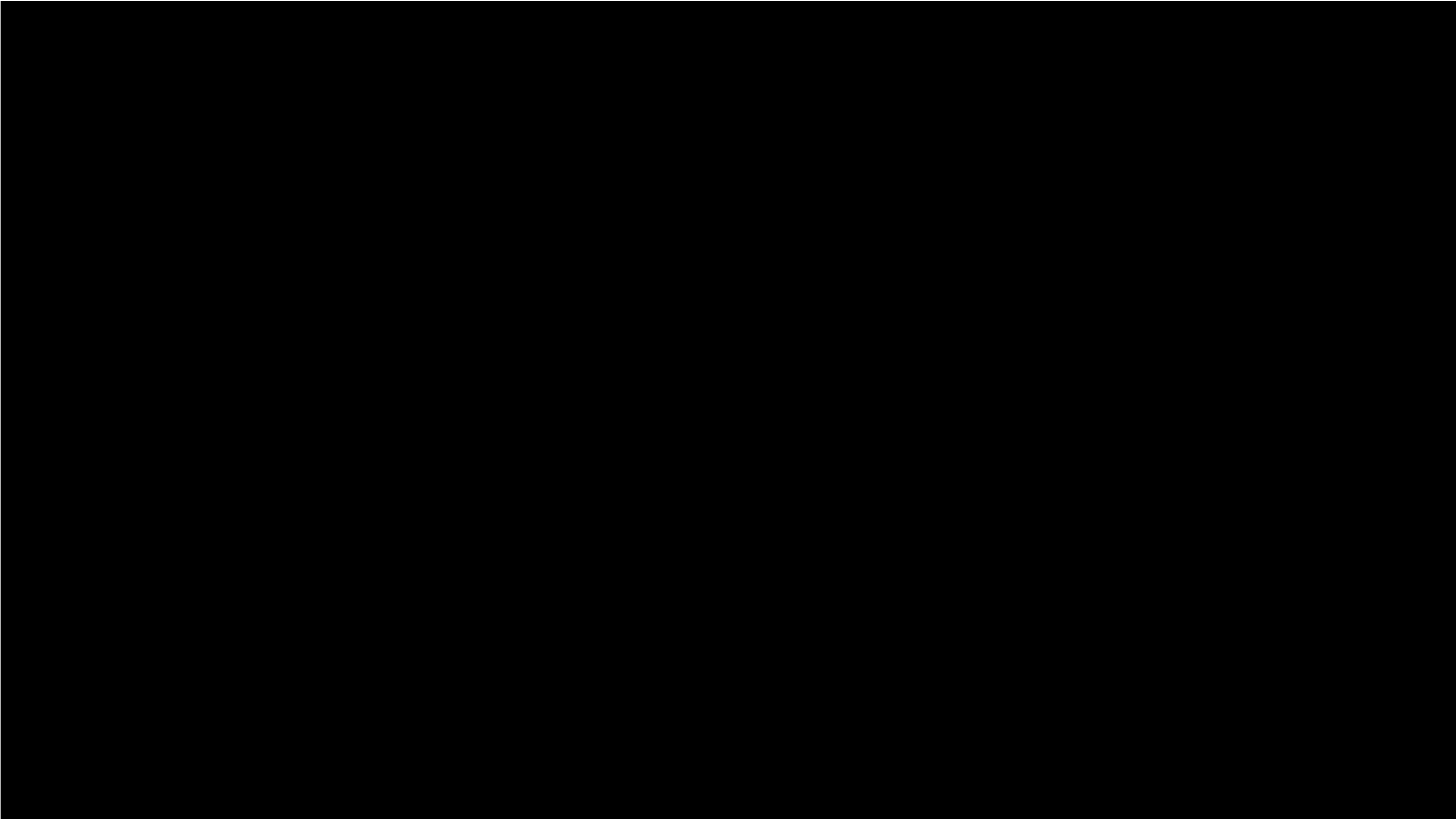

CLEP offers exams in German, French and Spanish and provides the opportunity for students to earn up to 12 credits

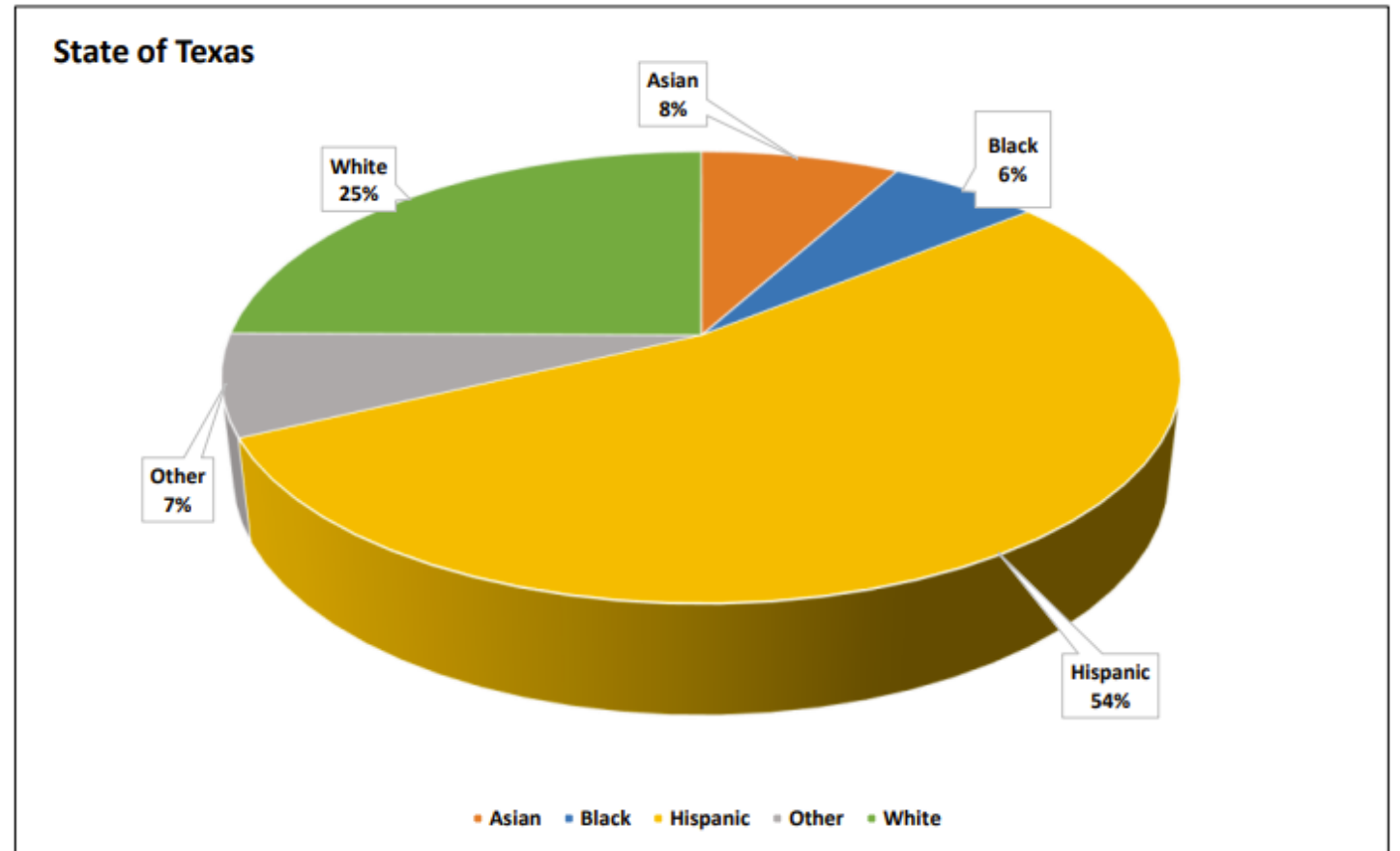

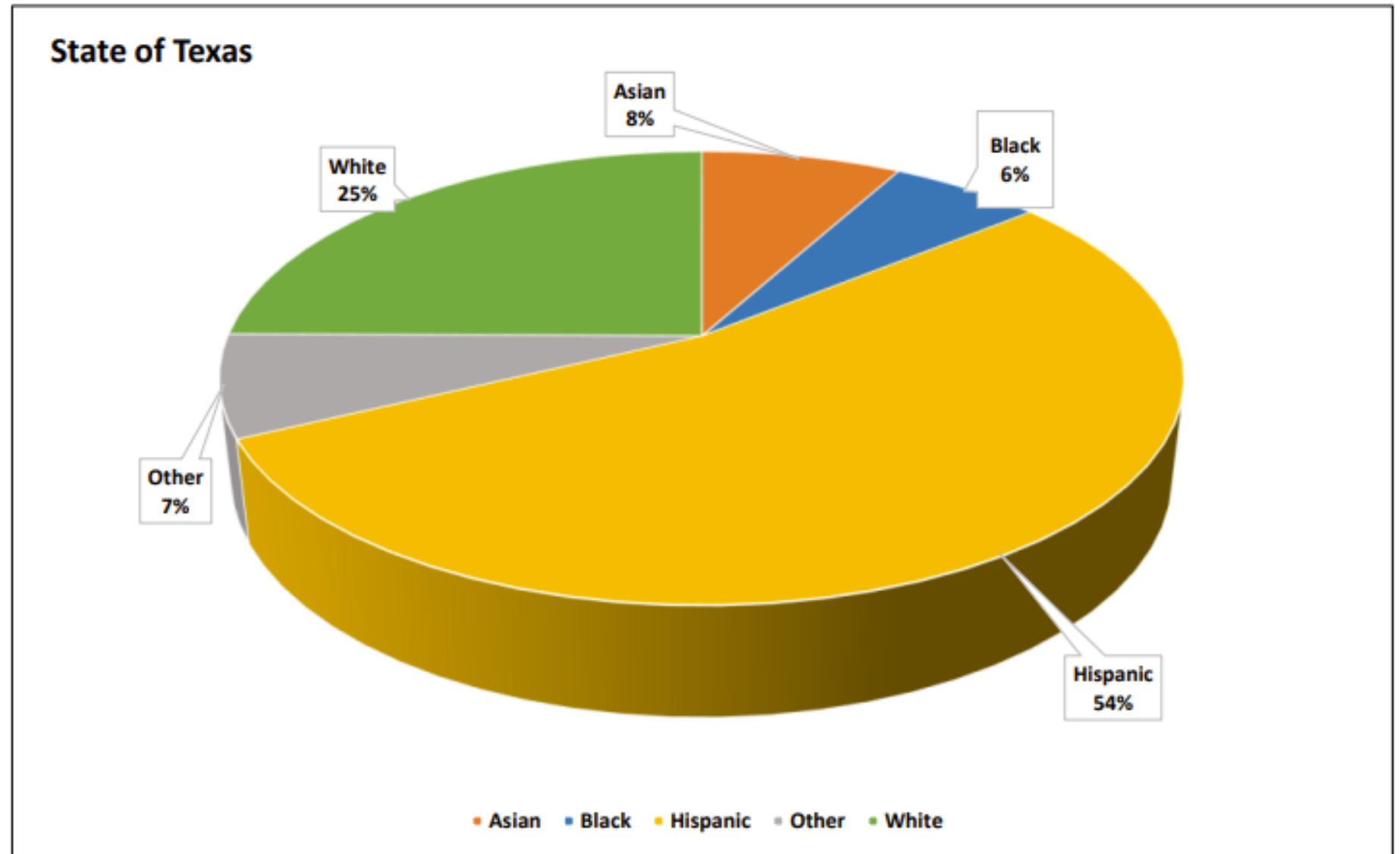

2022- 2023 Demographics



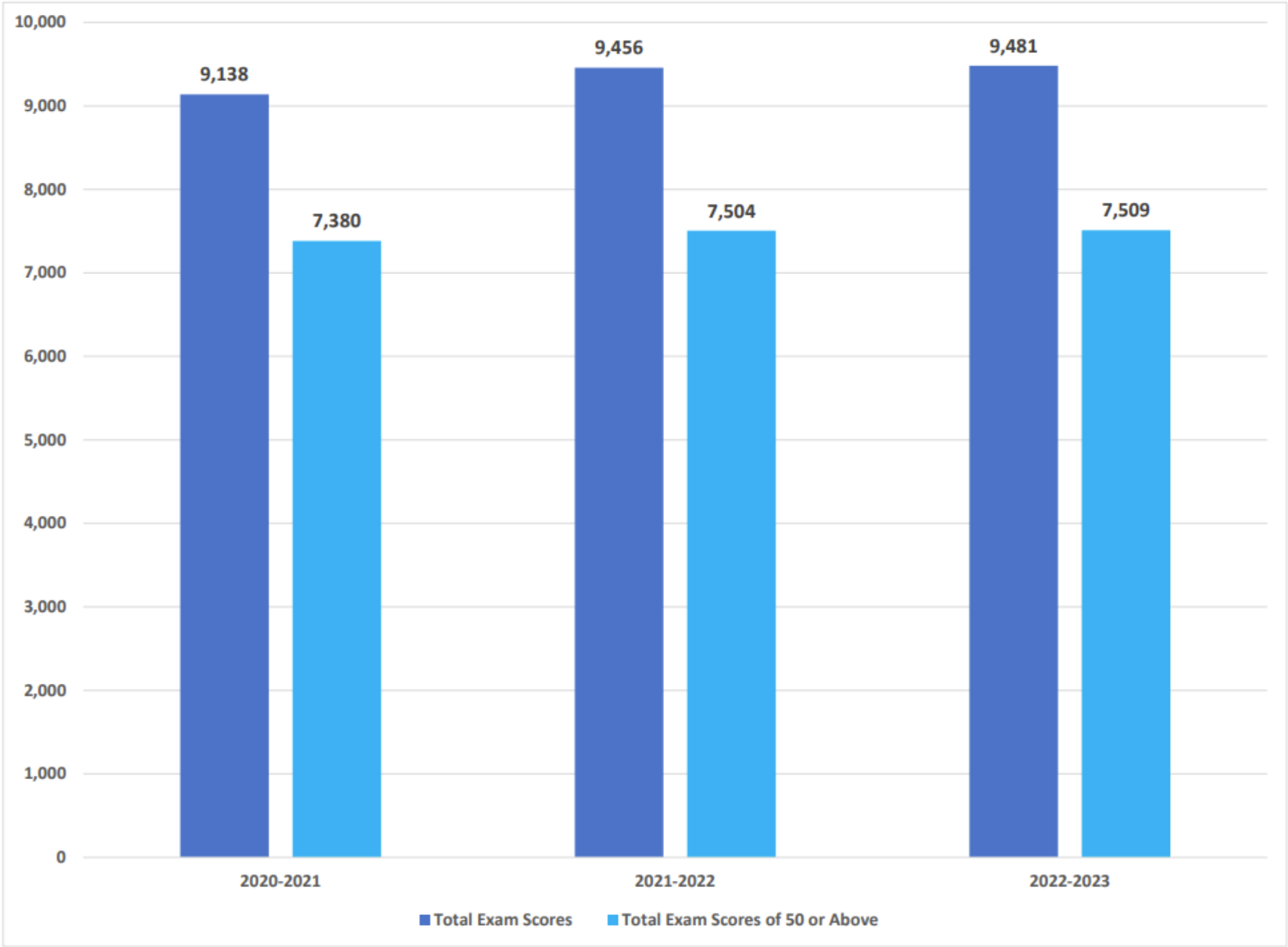

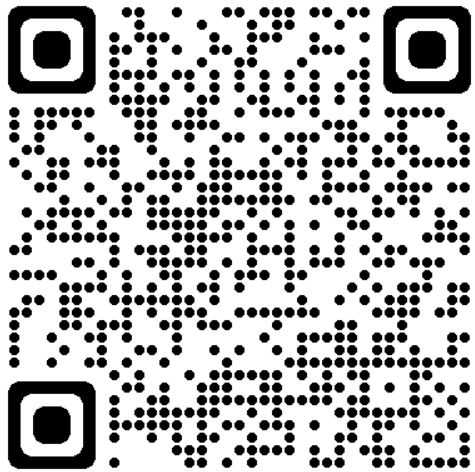

Passing a **CLEP exam** correlates to a **17.1%** increase in degree completion for Associate Degree students; **2.6%** increase for Bachelor Degree students. This effect is notably strong for student groups who traditionally struggle to graduate:

Students in the **military**

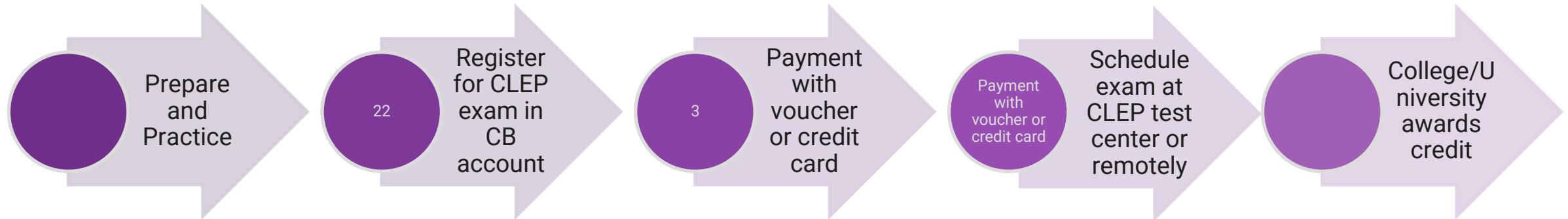
Students aged **25 or older**
