

Checking and Updating Adobe Flash Player

- Go to the following URL: www.adobe.com/software/flash/about. On the resulting page, shown below, you will be able to see which version of the Adobe Flash Player your device is currently running. If it is anything earlier than 18,0,0,209 (such as 18,0,0,203 shown below), you will need to update Flash Player in order to view streaming contents in the Firefox browser.

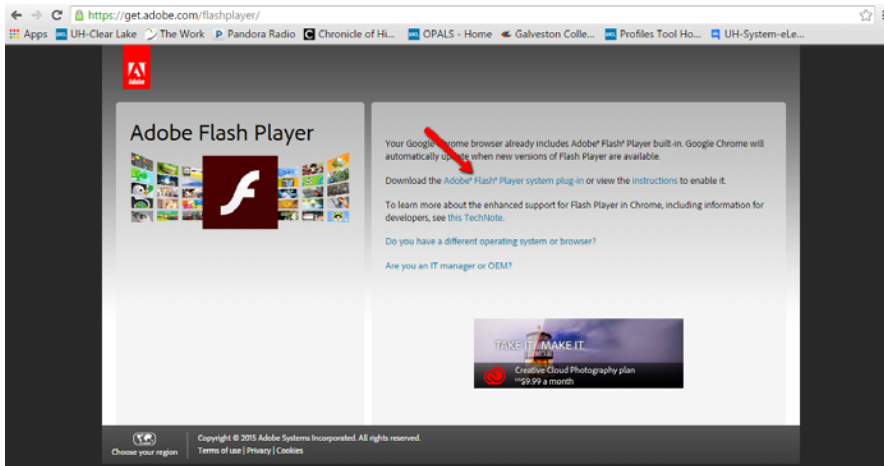
- To upgrade, begin by clicking the Player Download Center link.

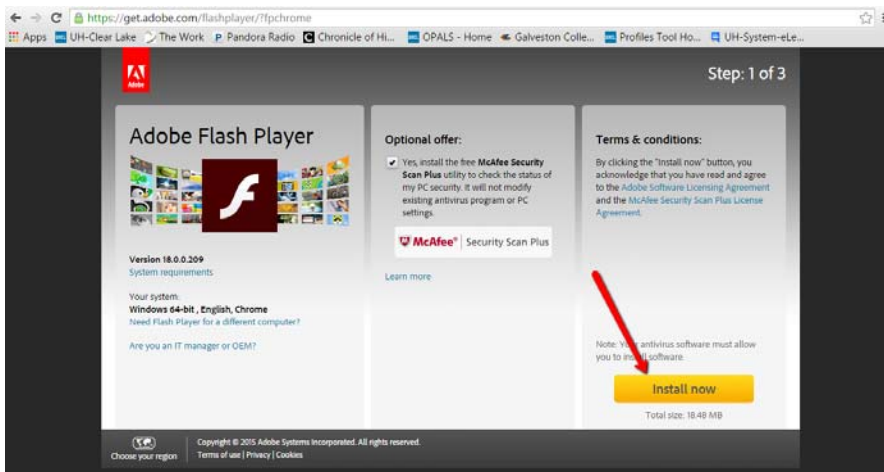

- At the resulting page, click the Adobe Flash Player system plug-in link.



- At the next screen, click the Install now button. NOTE: If installing on a UHCL workstation, you can de-select the Optional offer to “install the free McAfee Security Scan Plus,” as it cannot be installed on networked campus devices (UHCL already has its own security software in place).



- If Firefox is open on your device, you will need to close it and re-start for the update to take effect. After you do so, embedded streaming videos should look like the following example:
