HOW TO CONNECT TO UHCLPRIVATE ON ANDROID DEVICES

- Wi-Fi Network Name (SSID): UHCLPrivate
- Authentication is required;
 - 1. Select **Settings**.
 - 2. Select Wireless & Networks.
 - 3. Select the network **UHCLPrivate**
 - 4. Set the following options; EAP method: **PEAP**

CA certificate: (unspecified)
User certificate: (unspecified)

Enter the correct domain, your userid and your password.


For all UHCL faculty and staff the domain is **UHCL**.


For all students, the domain is **PCLAB**.
