

How to Connect Android 14 to UHCL Private Wi-Fi

1. Open Wi-Fi Settings


- Go to **Settings > Connections > Wi-Fi**.

2. Find UHCL Private

- Look for and select **UHCL Private** under the available networks.


3. Enter Network Details

- After selecting **UHCL Private**, you'll be directed to a new window. Fill in the required fields as shown in the reference images.
- **Identity:** Enter your username without "@uhcl.edu"
 - Example for employees: **smith**
 - Example for student: **pclab\smith**
- Enter your university password
- CA certificate: select **use system certificate**
- Domain: Enter "**uhcl.edu**"
- Tap **Connect**



4. Check Advanced Settings

- If the connection fails, tap on **More** or **Advanced** (depending on your phone model). Ensure the **Anonymous Identity** field is empty. Some versions may automatically fill this field; simply delete any content.
