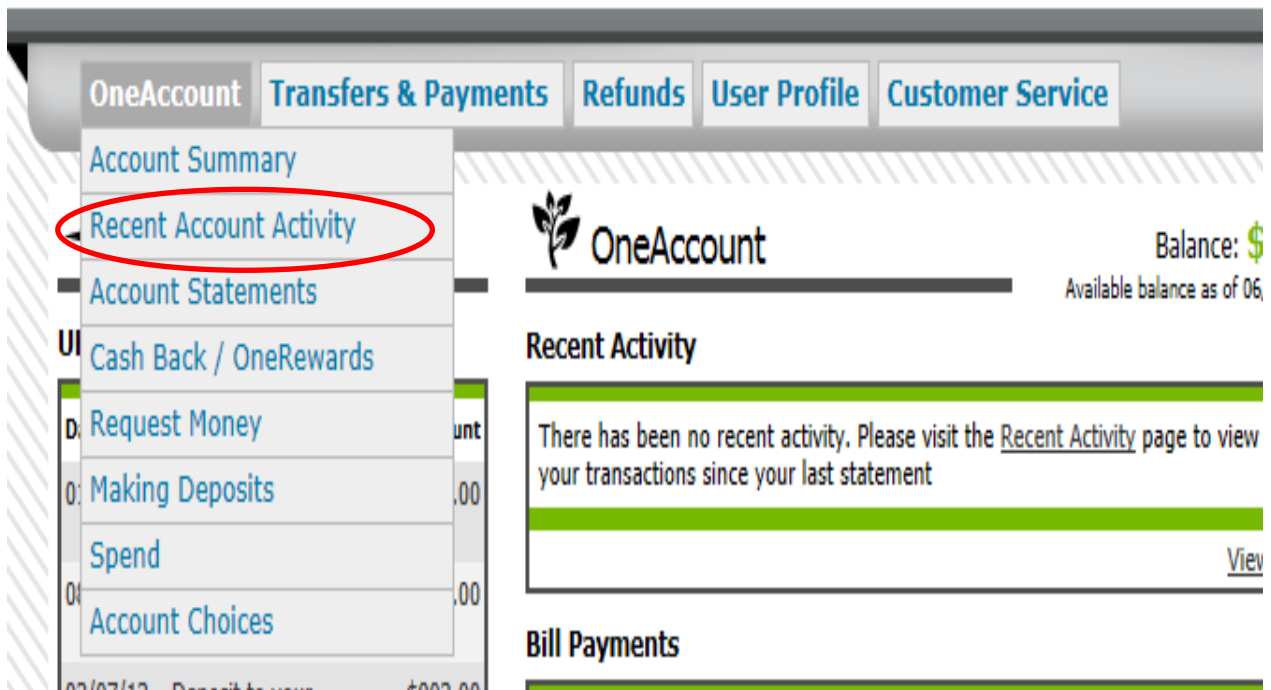
Use Your OneAccount to Avoid the Processing Fee!

Pay **ONLINE** using your HigherOne routing and account information.

Did you know that behind your UHCL HigherOne Debit MasterCard is a checking account? YES, like other checking/debit accounts established at banking institutions, your UHCL HigherOne account is a checking/debit account. You can order paper checks (*charges apply*) from HigherOne's online customer service. But even better, you can use the routing and account numbers to pay online by via "Online Bill Pay" for tuition, fees and emergency loan payments and avoid the 1.15% processing fee that is assessed when using a credit or debit card. It's easy, it's fast, and it's **FREE!**

Follow these simple steps to find your routing and account information.

1. Once logged into the HigherOne website, the top of the main page has drop down menus for OneAccount, Transfers & Payments, Refunds, User Profile, and Customer Service. Place your mouse over the OneAccount menu; select Recent Account Activity.



2. On the Recent Account Activity page, there will be general information listed. This will include the student address, **routing number**, **account number**, and wire transfer number, along with the account balance.

3. Entering the Routing Number and Account Number in the E-check information fields of the Online Payment screen and accepting the terms, authorizes the electronic deduction of the payment amount from your UHCL One account. Your payment is posted immediately.
