



BECOME A VOLUNTEER VOTER DEPUTY REGISTRAR!

The Dean of Students Office invites you to join us on **Thursday, September 15 from 4-5pm** in the **Forest Room (Bayou 1431)**

Please arrive no later than 3:45pm. Participants must arrive on time and attend the training in its entirety. The training is open to students, faculty, staff, and the community. Visitor parking rates apply. Visit www.uhcl.edu/parking for parking rates and instructions.

In order to encourage voter registration, Texas election law provides for County Voter Registrars to designate individuals to assist in the registration of eligible persons to vote. These individuals are appointed as Volunteer Deputy Registrars and operate under State rules and the supervision of the County Voter Registrar.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to serve as a Volunteer Deputy Voter Registrar, you **MUST** be:

- ★ at least 18 years of age
- ★ a citizen of the United States
- ★ a resident of Texas

In addition to the rules above, a Volunteer Deputy Voter Registrar **MUST NOT** have been:

- ★ determined by final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
- ★ finally convicted of a felony or, if a felon, fully discharged of sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, supervision, completed period of probation, or have been pardoned (Texas Election Code, §13.031(d)).
- ★ A person is not considered to have been finally convicted of an offense if the person's adjudication of guilt was deferred (H.B. 1226, 82nd Leg.).
- ★ finally convicted of Fraudulent Use or Possession of Identifying Information (Texas Penal Code, § 32.51).
- ★ finally convicted of a Class A misdemeanor relating to performance-based compensation for voter registration (Texas Election Code, §13.008).
