Process Overview for Academic Honesty and Code of Conduct Complaints

Code of Conduct Complaint

Alleged conduct violation (non-academic) of student or student organization results in written referral to Dean of Students.

May be submitted by students, faculty or staff.

Academic Honesty Violation

Alleged academic violation results in written referral to Dean of Students by instructor. If student does not agree or accept instructor's sanction, student may file written appeal to Dean of Students.

Preliminary Hearing

Student receives summons by letter from Dean of Students.

Failure to appear when summoned may result in suspension of student until further notice.

Dean of Students

determines if further action

is required.

Judicial Hearing

Academic Honesty Council hears academic violations, while Hearing Officer handles non-academic violations.

Case dismissed. No Is student responsible?

Student may appeal decision to
Provost for academic violations, or to
Student Life Council for non-academic violations.
