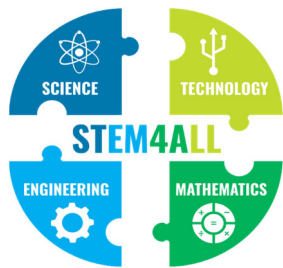




STEM4ALL Summer Institute
