2021 Virtual Texas Envirothon Oral Question Rules

- Teams will receive the question and relevant information on the morning of May 8, 2021 via access to a Google site.
- Teams need to answer the question by preparing a presentation that will be delivered over Zoom to a team of judges on the afternoon of Saturday, May 15, 2021.
- To receive the full point each presentation should be 17-20 minutes. An extra 10 minutes is allocated to answer questions.
- All team members need to take part in the preparation and delivery of the presentation.
- Presentations may be prerecorded. However, team members must make themselves available over Zoom at the time their presentation is played for the judges in order to answer questions.
- Prerecorded presentations must be uploaded by midday on Friday, May 14, 2021.
- Presentation order will be decided by drawing names out of a hat.
- Students may use any resources they wish; however, a full, properly written bibliography should be provided.
- All illustrations, charts, photographs, etc., used in the presentation must be credited.
- Only video clips created by the team members may be used.
- Any solution to creating a joint project while maintaining school guidelines and social distance rules will be accepted by Texas Envirothon.
- We prefer that students speak to the camera without a mask, however if a mask has to be worn, please speak clearly. Subtitles may be used; or a written draft of the presentation submitted by midday, Friday, May 14, 2021 would be appreciated.
