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

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
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Ally Micro Overview





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Ally Course Accessibility Report

- It's in all Canvas shells, but instructors need to put it onto their course menu to access it.
- Ally is actively scanning all content in all Canvas courses...all the time.
 - Removing old unused and duplicate files is often a quick way to improve a course's accessibility score.
 - New content will be reflected in the Ally system within 24 hours.

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

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Canvas Accessibility Checker Overview

The Canvas Accessibility Checker is built in and automatically evaluates any content that you add via Canvas' Rich Content Editor interface.

- If you type text directly into the Canvas RCE and use built-in headings, your content will very likely pass the checker with flying colors.
- If you do a lot of copy/paste between Word, Google Docs, etc., into the Canvas RCE, make sure to use the Accessibility Checker!

EchoVideo Captions/Transcripts



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EchoVideo Micro Overview

EchoVideo is UHCL's approved application for creating, storing, and deploying instructor-created video content for use in Canvas.

- Universal Capture (Classroom and Personal)
- Video Uploads/Zoom Cloud Recordings
- Basic Editing
- Embedded Questions (Polling)
- Student Engagement Data
- Captions/Transcripts
- Hyperlink
- Embedded Videos
- EchoVideo "Course" Link

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Don't Rely Only on Technology!

EchoVideo is UHCL's approved application for creating, storing, and deploying instructor-created video content for use in Canvas.

- Providing captions and transcripts is a great start toward digital accessibility. However, you must still review your videos for instances in which you present images, charts, tables, etc. that you don't also fully describe in the narration!
- Beware phases such as "As shown on this slide" or "As shown here" in your captions and transcripts. They can alert you to instructionally critical graphics that need to be made clear, especially for students with low or now vision.
