Annual Reviews – criteria are being revised by each college based on the revised Post-Tenure Review Policy. Each college is working to have something in place before the start of the fall semester.

Senate Committee Report – Teaching & Research – Dr. Shan

A review of the report was provided. Questions on insufficient response rate, student notifications, size of classes, multiple submissions, and issues with broken links occurred. Thank you's were expressed to the committee, OIT, and Marketing and Communications.

Senate Committee Report – Budget & Facilities – Dr. Brown

Nothing to add to the report. No questions were asked.

A review of the report was provided. It was shared that an emphasis will be given to having a Merit Raise pool in place and will be discussed at University Council. UH System has made the decision not to request an increase on tuition and fees but may request them at a special board meeting if

an increase to formula funding is not provided after the Legislative Session. Questions and discussions on effects of freezing tuitions and finding funds occurred.

Teaching & Research Committee- Gene Shan, Chair

- Provided feedback to OIT about the course evaluation website
- Provided feedback to Vice Provost Matthew about course modality changes
 - The feedback and changes have been shared with Deans Council
- Reviewed and revised the Academic Appeals Policy
 - The committee hopes to complete the revisions at its May meeting

 - The workgroup will include faculty from each college and representatives from administration

- Dana Gazda is continuing to work on processes and procedures for credit bearing certificates

Faculty Life Committee- Neal Dugre, Chair

- Made final edits to the P&T Policy, including the change requested by UHS Legal so that a faculty member who goes up early for tenure will not have an opportunity to be reviewed again
 - Senate will vote on the proposed edits at the May meeting

Restructured and updated the Adjunct Faculty Handbook

University Life Committee- Angela Kelling, Chair

- Discussed a flyer posting policy
- Retired several policies that have system level versions or are covered in the student handbook

Facilities & Support Services Committee, Becky Huss-Keeler, Chair

- Pending issues from previous meetings were reviewed and any updates were noted
- Mr. Denney reviewed the final portion of the UHCL Master Plan, which included the Pearland campus plan
 - Members gave input
- Dr. Hamidi shared the proposed 2023-2024 parking fee table
 - Showed a slight increase from the current fees
 - These fees have not been approved yet
- FSSC is not scheduled to meet again this academic year

Planning & Budget Committee- Tim Michael, Chair

- PBC met on 4/19 to discuss the results of this year's Budget Initiatives evaluation, and the Budget Office presented a summary of scores
 - At the last several meetings, it was made clear by Mr. Denney that another annual merit raise pool was considered to be a "super priority" for both Mr. Denney and President Walker
 - o This would be separate from any proposals from individual units
 - The committee voted to approve a ranking of the proposals presented in March (a very limited list compared with the original from fall) and to forward these to University Council for their May meeting
- The committee had a first read of an interim travel policy and a new risk management policy
- The committee's next meeting will be on 5/17
