# UHCL Faculty Senate Committee Reports – May 2022

## Faculty Senate Committees

# Budget & Facilities Committee – Ishaq Unwala, Chair

- The committee met on 4/29 to review the draft Faculty Compensation policy
- Committee members reviewed the draft policy via TEAMs.
- The suggestions have been incorporated in the policy in the package.
- Majority of committee agreed on promotion increment method and amounts, via email Apr 1, reviewed and discussed a rough draft of the Faculty Pay policy

## Curriculum Committee - Becky Huss-Keeler, Chair

- The curriculum committee reviewed the Duolingo Assessment statistics from the International Admissions Office which were required to be reviewed at the end of the academic year to determine if UHCL wanted to keep Duolingo as one of the tests for admission along with the TEOFL and IELTS exams. After committee review of the materials provided by Dr. Johanna McClendon in International Admissions it was decided to allow the policy to expire as an exam option in December 2022 for the following reasons:
  - There was not enough human oversight of the exam. It was monitored and scored by Artificial Intelligence.
  - o It measured conversational, social level English vs. academic English used in university classes
  - Not enough studies have been conducted on its effectiveness
  - International Admissions indicated that compared to the number of international applicants who took Duolingo and submitted scores, a low number of students actually enrolled in UHCL as compared to applicants who took the other two exam options.
- The committee started discussing the implementation procedures for the Credit Bearing Certificate Policy and this will continue at our May 12th meeting.

  - o Early Childhood Intervention Certificate
  - Credit Bearing Certificate Policy
  - Latin Honors Policy Revision
  - o Business Start Up Minor
  - Duolingo test results review and recommendation for sunset in December 2023
  - Credit Bearing Certificate Procedures (possibly finalized this summer)

## Faculty Life Committee - Sarah Costello, Chair

- NTT policy revisions passed Faculty Life, shared here as first read.
- Faculty life has begun to review edits to the Emeritus policy, at the request of the Council of Professors.

## Teaching & Research Committee – Anton Dubrovskiy, Chair

TRC analyzed currently used course evaluation questions from all the four Colleges as well as any
suggested questions we've received at this point. Out of 163 original questions, 6 questions were selected
to be shared with the administration and 5 questions were selected to be shared with the students.
Additional details are provided in the attached recommendations file. We are still waiting on SGA
feedback (on the student set of questions), so might do a friendly amendment during the FS meeting if
students' feedback alters the selected questions.

## Governance Committee - Elizabeth Beavers, Chair

- The Governance Committee is drafting an introduction for the revised Faculty Handbook.
- Grievance Panel Elections will be forthcoming
- We will be collaborating with Policy Management office to clean up formatting of policies and other items that pass through Faculty Senate
