### POSITION SUMMARY

The UCT is a university-wide computing and telecommunications resource for students, faculty, and staff at University of Houston Clear Lake. The UCT is comprised of a number of functional units that are responsible for the proper maintenance of hardware and software support of the academic and administrative user communities. The Executive Director for Computing is the senior campus officer for all Computing and Telecommunications Services. The scope of this position includes Administrative Computing, Academic Computing and Telecommunications. Responsibilities include executive leadership for all computing and telecommunications personnel, the formulation of all plans and budgets for both the near and long term, and for directing, organizing, and coordinating the UCT resource. In discharging these responsibilities, the Executive Director for Computing reports through the Associate Vice President for Information Resources and interacts with the President, the Vice Presidents, Deans, Associate Deans, Directors, faculty, staff, and students throughout the campus. In addition, this position is responsible for the appropriate technical interfaces with UH-System and other UH Campuses.

Responsible for the assessment of needs and planning for computing and telecommunications. Develop, implement, and monitor budgetary plans and goals in accordance with the University of Houston-Clear Lake priorities and shared governance structure.	20
Responsible for the organization, implementation, and operation of academic computing, administrative computing, networks and telecommunications. Create and recommend policies, procedures, and guidelines for the UCT Department through the appropriate shared governance structure.	20
Recruit, hire, train, evaluate, and develop a professional staff to guide, execute, and participate in the delivery of academic and administrative computing and technology services for the University.	15
