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BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

I am a geographer with a life-long passion for travel and teaching. In 1992 I earned a B.A in Art History from the University of Texas at Austin. I then studied in San Francisco at Transworld Teachers where I received a certificate to teach English as a Second Language and did so in San Jose, Costa Rica. In 1994, I started my graduate career at Texas State University at San Marcos, and began working with the Texas Alliance for Geographic Education. I earned a master's degree in geography education in 1996. I then took a leave of absence, moved to Morocco and taught geography at Al Akhawayn University. I returned to Texas State in 1997 and completed a Doctor of Philosophy in Geography in 2001. In the same year, I accepted an appointment at the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL) and founded the Geography Program and implemented a BS in Geography as well as a Minor in Geographic Information Systems (GIS). At UHCL, I have taught over a dozen different geography courses, directed field study programs on three continents, and established an interdisciplinary GIS laboratory. As a scholar, I focus on human development through geography education and geospatial technology. I have been awarded two Fulbright Scholarships one to the University of Belgrade in Belgrade, Serbia (2009-2010), and the other to the University of Johannesburg, South Africa (2019). Currently, I am the President-elect of the National Council of Geographic Education and serve as the State of Texas Geography Steward for the National Geographic Society.
