I am very pleased to inform you that UHCL's Center for Autism and Developmental Disabilities (CADD) was the first recipient of the University of Houston System (UHS) Regents' Academic Excellence Award. The award was announced and presented at the quarterly meeting of the UHS Board of Regents on Aug. 20, 2015. Congratulations to all of our faculty, staff and students associated with CADD including the graduate programs of behavior analysis, school psychology and family therapy. Our faculty, staff and students associated with these nationally accredited programs have provided exemplary teaching, research and service.
