



## **Full-time Internship - Occupational Safety and Health**

### **Summary of the role:**

The Occupational Safety and Health internship is designed to provide participants with challenging and rewarding health and safety experiences that enable them to develop leadership and functional skills. Selected candidates will be passionate about a career in the health & safety field and the chemical manufacturing industry.

### **Essential Functions:**

- Major focus will be providing plant support of safety and industrial hygiene risk assessment activities (ex. Job Safety Analysis, Occupational Risk Assessment), including editing / updating plant risk assessment databases, analysis / report creation of data contained in Impact database, incident and behavior based safety (BBS) modules, and maintenance of training management system records
- Assist with maintenance of safety data sheet (SDS) database
- Perform field safety support, such as audits, inspections, and hazard identification.
- Assist in employee safety training programs
- Conduct field inspections and manage inspection checklists.
- Update health and safety records and procedures in various management system tools
- Create work safety process procedures
- Assist leadership with the implementation of site safety initiatives and required written documentation.
- Work closely with health and safety leadership, site workers and contractors to achieve overall, health, safety, operational and business objectives.
- Participate in company sponsored training

### **Duration & location:**

- Full time through 2018, beginning May 2018
- Position will be based in Crosby, Texas
- May involve travel to other Arkema sites in the Gulf Coast area, predominantly day trips, but may also include occasional travel within the continental US.

### **Qualifications:**

- Currently enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited U.S. college or university with senior status
- GPA of at least 3.0/4.0
- Pursuing a B.S. degree in Industrial Hygiene or Industrial Safety and Health
- Must have legal U.S. citizenship or working authorization

- Demonstrated communication and leadership skills, with strong interpersonal skills
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, as well as solid analytical problem solving skills are extremely valuable.
- Ability to plan and organize work to effectively perform assigned tasks in a timely manner
- Ability to work independently, learn new tasks/handle multiple tasks, solve problems, meet deadlines, and show strong self-motivation and initiative
